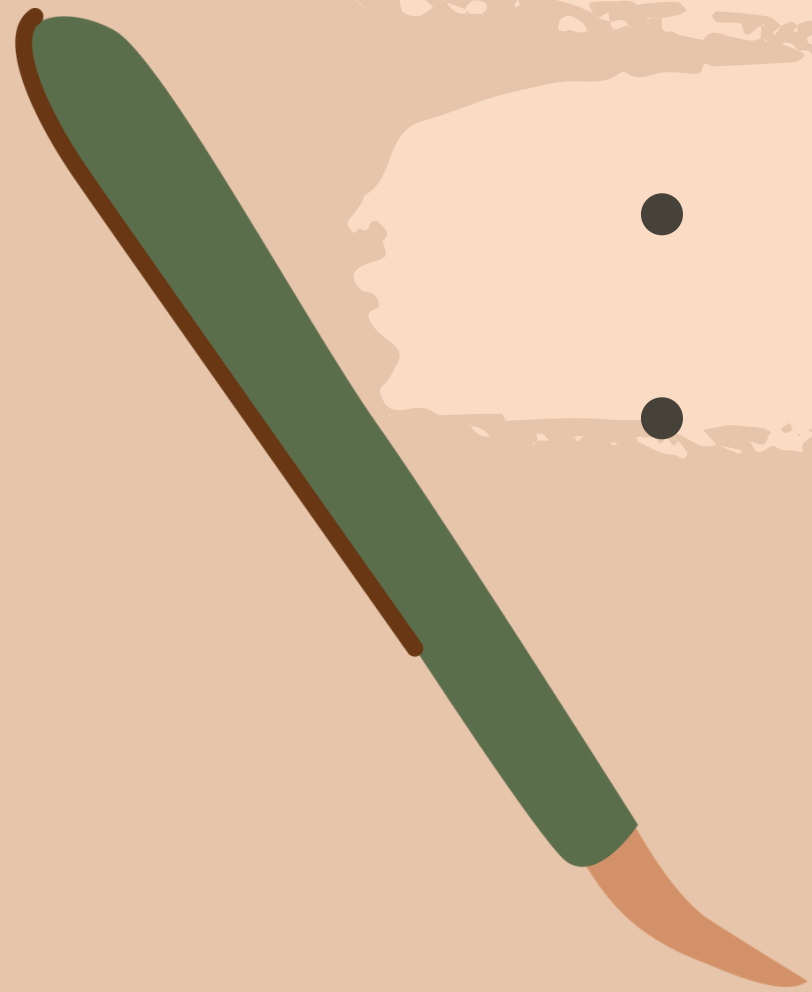


DOUBLE-SIDED
FLEECE BLANKET

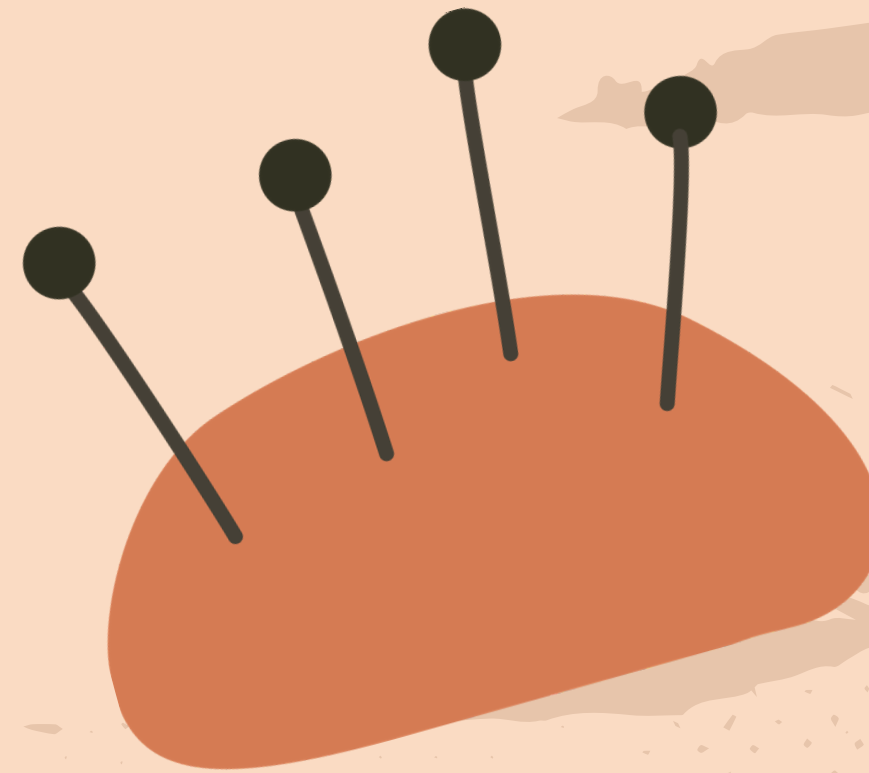


EQUIPMENT

- TWO PIECES OF FLEECE FABRIC
(1.5 YDS OR 2 YDS)
- SCISSORS
- A FLAT SURFACE



STEP 1: LINE UP THE FABRIC



- Lay the two fleece pieces on a flat surface with the back sides of each piece together (the sides you don't want showing).
- Make sure all edges line up evenly.

STEP 2: CUT THE CORNERS

- Cut a 4 inch by 4 inch square out of each corner. This helps the edges lie flat when tied.

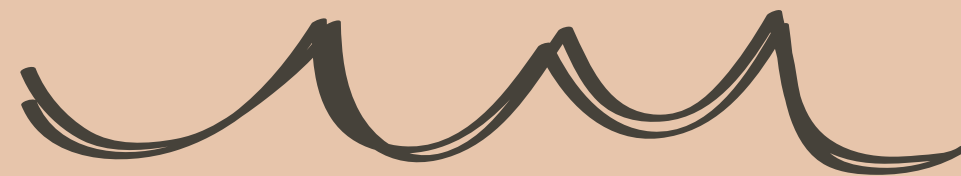
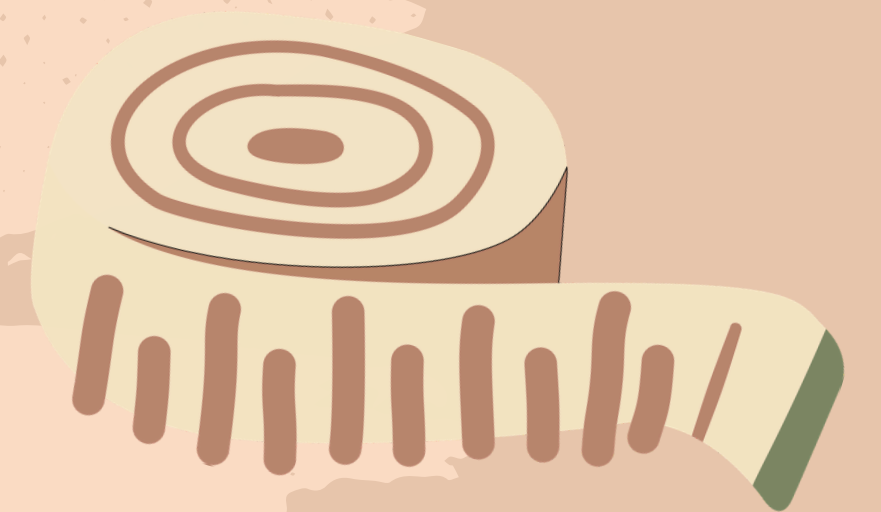
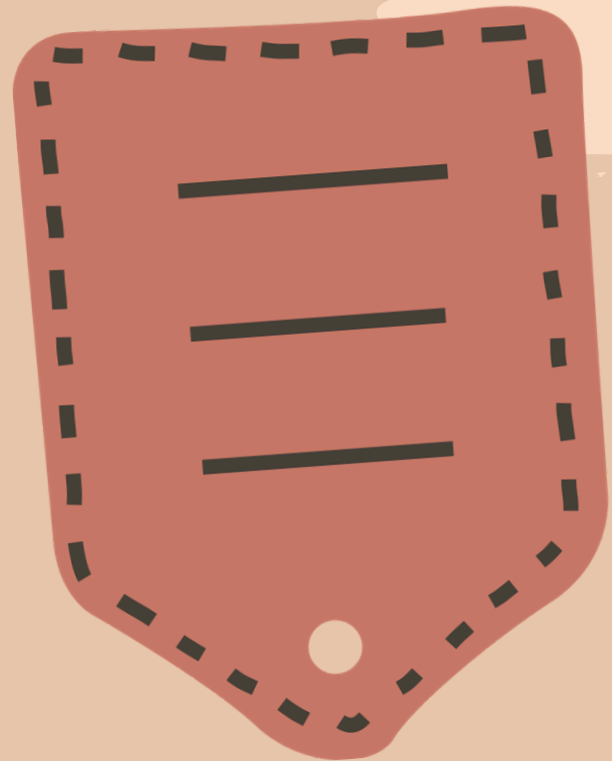


STEP 3: CUT FRINGE

Along all four sides, cut strips:

- About 1 inch wide
- About 4 inches long

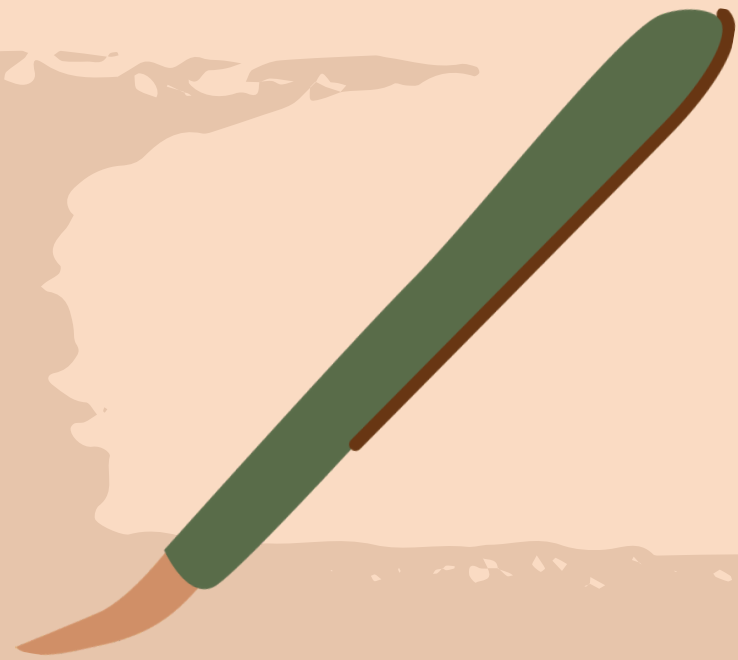
Cut through both layers at the same time so the fringe matches.



STEP 4: START TYING KNOTS

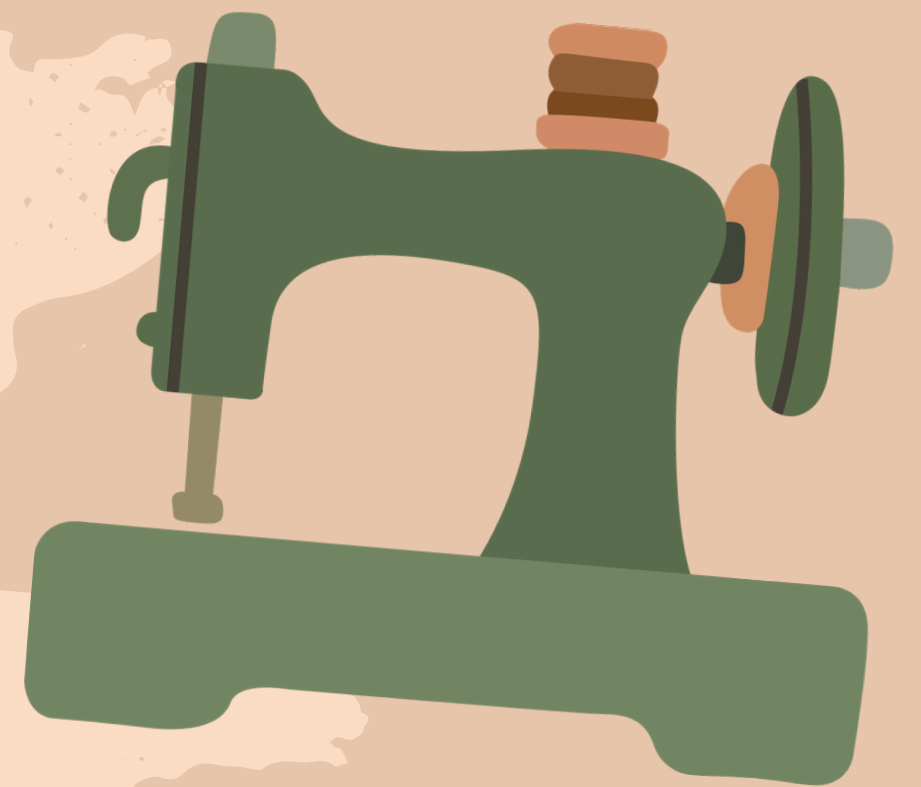


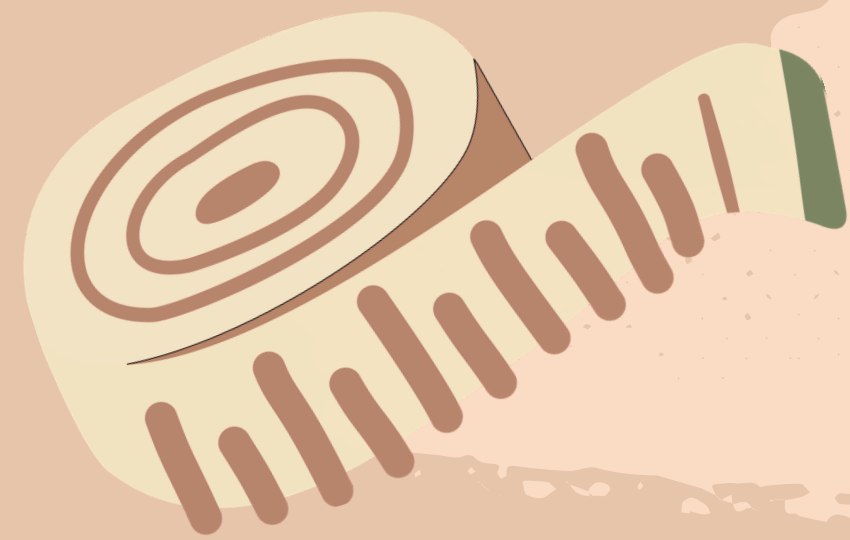
- Take one strip from the top layer and the matching strip from the bottom layer.
- Tie them together using a simple double knot (right over left, then left over right).



STEP 5: CONTINUE AROUND BLANKET

- Repeat tying knots all the way around the blanket.
- Keep the knots snug but not too tight so the fleece stays soft.





FINISH & STRAIGHTEN

- Once all sides are tied, gently pull the blanket flat and straighten the fringe if needed.
